Highlights of Campaign Finance Changes - 2017 General Session

Bills below are effective May 9, 2017.

H.B. 52 Political Contribution Reporting Amendments – Rep. Daw

• Makes it a class B misdemeanor to conspire to make a campaign contribution through one or more persons in order to avoid disclosing the original source of the campaign contribution.

H.B. 160 Campaign Contribution Solicitation Amendments – Rep. Arent

• Prohibits a person from using the email of a public entity (e.g., @le.utah.gov, @utah.gov, @county.gov, @schooldistrict.org) to solicit a campaign contribution.

S.B. 275 Campaign Finance Reporting Amendments – Sen. Hillyard

Repeals provisions related to a corporation reporting donors.

H.R. 2 Resolution Modifying House Rules – Rep. Dunnigan
